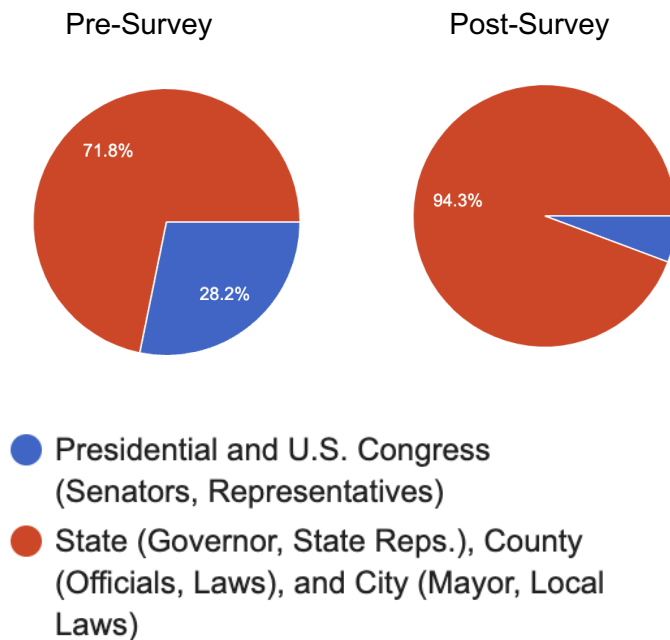
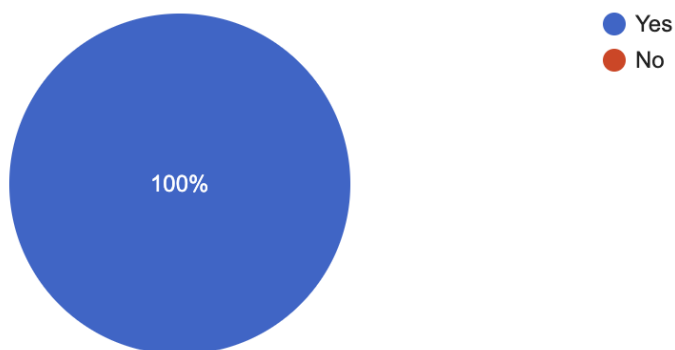


Which election impacts you the most?



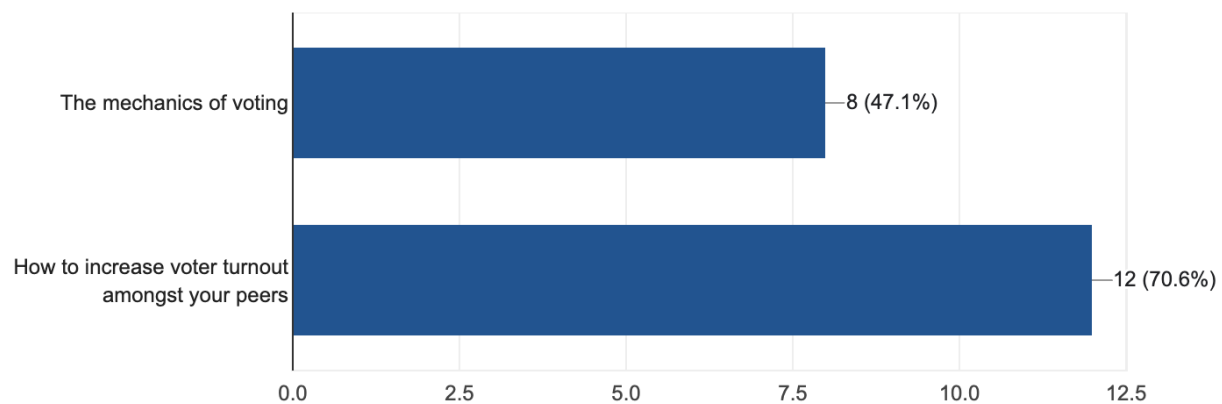
A positive change of 22%

Do you think that it's important that your generation votes at the same rate as people over 45?



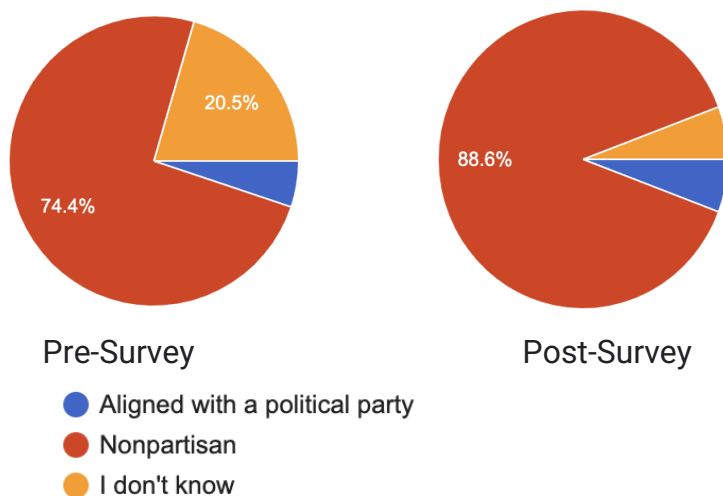
100% of students surveyed agree that youth voting is important!

Thank you again for the opportunity to present Energizing Young Voters to the Superintendent's Student Advisory Council on March 13.

As you can see, the LWV Energizing Young Voters Presentation energized your student voters, attached are the metrics from the presentation. In summary:

100% of students surveyed agree that youth voting is important!
70% want to influence peers to also vote.
47% want more info on mechanics of voting.

After the presentation, one Student, Fred Zoegdrager, stood and handed Pirie his business card and stated he wanted to be a leader in a social media initiative to inspire peers to vote. The quote on his card are my sentiments as well:
"Try not. Do. Or do not. There is no try." Yoda

Now, how do we harness and enhance the enthusiasm expressed?

We would like to offer activities at the St. Vrain schools in May and or next fall on the mechanics of voting and inspiring peers to vote. The League of Women Voters and potentially County Election office officials would attend.

In order to schedule fall presentations and voting mechanics activities, we would like to contact St. Vrain School Principals and Teachers (who mentor school clubs, such as social studies, government, debate or model UN.). We would like to send an email with the slide show presentation and metrics attached, noting: this presentation was given to the Superintendent's Student Advisory Council, with Dr. Haddad's approval, March of 2024.

Student participation and leadership in presentations or activities would be a priority in the Energizing Young Voters Initiative. I think harnessing the enthusiasm expressed by the students would be "ripe fruit" for participation. How could we invite the Superintendent's Student Advisory Council members to be involved in the planning as well as active participants, once approval has been obtained by individual school principals?
