Why are voting methods such a HOT topic?




Plurality Voting

The most prevalent voting method in the US

Also known as

- Winner-take-all
- First-past-the-post (FPTP)
- Choose-one voting



What's Wrong with Plurality?

Plurality voting encourages people to vote strategically (with their head) instead of honestly (with their head and their heart) because if they don't ...



Spoiler Effect


...Two or more candidates may split the vote allowing the least popular candidate to win.

To Win a Plurality Election

-- Get more votes than anyone else --Do more votes equal many votes?

Plurality Rank Order Rating **Approval** Instant Plurality and Score Runoff

Plurality Ballot

Vote for ONE.

Approval Voting Ballot

Vote for ONE OR MORE.

- lemon bar

Score Voting Ballot

Rate EACH candidate.

No support = 0. Maximum support = 3.

An Important Distinction

Single-Winner: mayor, member of Congress, ward council-member

Versus

Multi-Winner: 2 or more seats filled in a single contest

Multi-Member Board Elections – 2 Types

Single-Winner Ward Contests Multi-Winner At-Large Contests Can Promote **Proportional Representation**

When Adopting a Better Voting Method

- Consider what the electorate wants
 - ranking vs rating, at-large vs districts

- Consider what election officials can feasibly implement
 - costs, post-election audits, statutory limits
